



IN-PERSON ORIENTATION INFORMATION

In order to facilitate the transition back to the building we have scheduled a series of orientation activities beginning Tuesday, March 16 through Friday, March 19th. **These orientation sessions are for students who will be returning to in-person instruction on March 22. Students who are remaining all-virtual will not attend these sessions.**

As discussed during the most recent Town Hall, each grade level will be assigned a day to attend. Students attending orientation will **not** have virtual classes on their assigned orientation day, but may have to make-up work for some classes. Students in the building will follow a full schedule of activities from 8:05 a.m. - 3:00PM.

Arrival

Drop-off will take place at the Dock entrance and students may arrive as early as 7:30. Student temperatures will be taken prior to building entry. All students are required to wear masks at all times, except when eating or drinking.

Orientation sessions will include locker assignments, a review of health and safety protocols, building expectations, and social activities! Students will be given a schedule of stops to attend in small groups, maintaining social distancing as much as possible.


Lunch
