

## 22-23 TSA Arts Supply List

Note: All Students will learn their class schedules during schedule pick up Days (Aug 25-26) Teachers generally spend the first day of classes going over the course syllabus and classroom rules, and activities that all students will be able to participate in whether or not they have all their supplies. By the second day, things are in full swing, so supplies should be in hand.

### All Sections of Band & Studio Winds

#### Beginning Band

Essential Elements- Book 1

#### Intermediate Band

Essential Elements- Book 22

**Studio Winds Book:** Foundations for a Superior Performance- for your primary instrument.

#### All Band Students Require:

- An instrument in good playing condition (rented, borrowed, or purchased). Please have the instrument checked over the summer for necessary repairs. If renting an instrument this should be done for you.
- Korg™ Tuner/ Metronome (or similar functioning phone app; iPad tuner apps are workable, but re cumbersome to use on music stands)
- ***Pencil for daily rehearsal***

#### Recommended for all Band Students:

- Roche Thomas Mi-T-Mist or Sterisol mouthpiece cleaner

#### All Woodwinds require:

- Clarinet/Sax Reeds: If Rico Royal (NOT "Orange box") -2 ½ for beginning, 3 or 3 ½ for Intermediate and Studio Winds; if using Vandoren, note that each reed strength plays about a half strength harder than Rico.
- Oboe/Bassoon Reeds: consult your private lesson instructor or course instructor for recommendations
- Reed guard or reed case for woodwind reeds
- Swab and Neck strap for Saxophone and Bass Clarinet
- Flute/Clarinet/Oboe require a lock for instrument locker

#### All Brass require:

- Valve oil (trumpet, French Horn, Euphonium, Tuba)
- Slide Oil (Trombone)
- Tuning slide grease
- Trumpet and small case alto saxes require a lock for an instrument locker

#### All Studio Winds will need:

- A small binder with 12-14 plastic sheet holders. Type/print your name on the front of the binder
- 2-4 large clips for holding music on the music stand.
- Folding/portable music stand; you will use this for home practice and for specific off-campus performances; if you can acquire a stand sturdier than the folding wire stands, it will work better.

If you need financial assistance acquiring supplies, send a note from a parent/guardian to your instructor immediately.
