Enrollment season begins and applications are available October 2, 2026 - create an account, start your application before the deadline

LOTTERY QUALIFICATION DEADLINE - JAN. 29, 2027 at 3PM

Submit all Required Documents

What documents are required?

- Each list is individualized and may take 24 hours to update in your parent portal (where you filled out the application) but you can expect to provide things like: birth certificate, proof of residency, grade cards, etc.
- You can submit them on your own electronically or bring them into TSA and we will scan and upload them for you.
- ALL documents must be submitted prior to the deadline of Jan. 29th at 3:00 PM to qualify for the lottery.

*Using a valid email that you check regularly is a top priority for application success!

What will TSA email me?

- Reminders that you still have missing documents.
- Requests for an update to a document you provided.

Where should I check?

TSA will post lottery results / wait list positions by grade on our website at www.ts4arts.org and on our front office door no later than 5:00 PM.

NEXT STEP DAY (If applicable) - Saturday, April 10th

- A limited number of students are invited to Next Step Day based on the order of their wait list number.
- Invitations with more details will be sent via email shortly after the lottery.
- Generally, families can expect to have their students participate in academic placement tests (6th grade), artistic auditions (will vary depending on grade level and artistic area of interest) and counseling department meetings.
- An invitation to Next Step Day neither guarantees nor determines entrance into TSA.
- More applicants are invited than we have spaces for to facilitate the wait list process.
- Next Step Day DOES NOT determine admittance into TSA and is only for class placement.

ENTERING 6th GRADERS

- All students are placed on a wait list in the order they were randomly drawn in the lottery.
- Students in positions 1 – 130 will receive an invitation to Next Step Day.
- Students in positions 1 – 115 can expect an offer letter in May.
- Lottery numbers 116 and beyond will remain on the waitlist and be notified if spaces become available. Waitlists will expire on Sept. 30.

ENTERING 7th - 12th GRADERS

- All students are placed on a wait list in the order they were randomly drawn in the lottery.
- Because current students have the opportunity to re-enroll, ALL students are waitlisted. Even if your student is drawn in the #1 position for their grade, they are waitlisted until a space in their grade is confirmed to be available.
- Initial offers will be made in May. Those not receiving an initial offer will remain on the waitlist and be notified if spaces become available. All waitlists will expire on Sept. 30.
